Through our partnership with Good Things Foundation, we've been able to distribute over 60 laptops to carers.

We've received some lovely feedback about the difference these laptops will make:

"I had one laptop and we were all sharing that. It was always hard for my 9 year old autistic son to wait for his turn. Now his sister and I are using the laptop and he was able to use his own device without the stress of waiting. Thank you very much."

"This laptop is a Godsend. I am doing an online course and everyone else has a laptop. I only have my phone to access the meetings and I felt like I was getting left behind, so this is just perfect for me!"

"I had prayed for something like this. I have been having to ask the children if I can borrow their laptops for my English course but now I have one of my very own. I am very happy."
